- a. Wrong. 'Is bigger as' is not **grammatically** correct.
- b. Wrong. 'Is more bigger than' is not **grammatically** correct.
- c. Wrong. This is not **factually** correct - England is NOT as big as China.
- d. Correct.

2.

- a. Wrong. 'Fell' is the past of 'to fall'.
- b. Correct. 'Felt' is the past of 'to feel'.
- c. Wrong. 'Feel' is the present of 'to feel'.
- d. Wrong. 'Fallen' is the past participle of 'to fall'.

3.

- a. Wrong. 'Ours' means belonging to us. E.g. That house is **ours**.
- b. Wrong. 'There's' means 'there is'.
- c. Wrong. 'Your' means belonging to you. E.g. Is that **your** book?
- d. Correct. 'You're' means 'you are'.

4.

- a. Wrong.
- b. Correct. E.g. 'How long does it take to get to school?' '20 minutes by bus.'
- c. Wrong.
- d. Wrong.

- a. Correct. Flowers always die. (verb, present tense)
- b. Wrong. Flowers always death (noun) is not correct.
- c. Wrong. Flowers always dead (adjective) is not correct.
- d. Wrong. I hate buying flowers, they always died (past tense) is not correct.

- a. Wrong.
- b. Wrong.
- c. Correct. If we agree with a negative statement (can't), we use **neither + positive** (can).
- d. Wrong.
